There is no access code – simply wait to be joined to the conference call. The prayer time has truly been a blessing to so many who have found comfort and strength in listening to the prayers, praise and hymns rendered unto the Lord. As we continue in our “Round the Clock” prayer time, we would like to make note of the following guidelines and purpose of our prayer time together.

- Please be mindful of others and be sure to **MUTE** your phone to eliminate any background noise that may disturb other participants (you will still be able to hear). If you do not have a mute button, please find a quiet place as you remain on the call. Unmute the call when and if you desire to pray or read scripture.
- It is not necessary for you to announce yourself if you join the call late or someone is speaking.
- Please refrain from personal conversations and comments before, during and after persons have prayed, read scriptures or devotionals – remember our focus is God – we are singing His praises, seeking His guidance and giving Him thanks.
- We are continuing to pray for:
 - Those infected with the virus for healing;
 - Comfort for those who have lost loved ones as a result of the virus and others who have passed on during this time and were unable to have their loved ones eulogized in traditional Homegoing Services;
 - Protection and peace for the medical professionals who are still attending to those affected with the virus and are putting their lives at risk in the process; police and 911 workers and others who put their lives on the line to be of service and help (delivery workers, clerks in various stores and janitorial staff, etc.); and
 - Protection for the last responders (funeral directors).
